Sackville Construction Ltd. takes the Health and Safety of all who come into contact with, are employed by and are affected by any works undertaken by us, The Company, responsibly and seriously.

Therefore, in line with the Health and Safety At Work Act 1974, our Health and Safety Policy is as follows;

HEALTH AND SAFETY STATEMENT OF INTENT

One of the most important functions of a responsible Construction Company is to undertake and complete projects to the highest standard with the utmost care taken to prevent accidents, ill health and stress to those in direct and indirect contact with the works.

We at Sackville Construction Ltd. intend to comply rigourously with all Health and Safety legislation, codes of practice and site requirements to maintain high standards of safety to minimise or eliminate risk and hazard on each site we are working on and are responsible for.

Sackville Construction Ltd will, as far as reasonably possible undertake:

1. A safe system of work: any Company employee will have received the adequate and essential training for the purposes of Health and Safety and the correct execution of the task.

This includes training in the correct methods, appropriate licences, correct and appropriate permits, the full PPE as required from risk assessments as well as an understanding of risk factors.

This should ensure that all strenuous measures are controlled as far as reasonably possible, as to not affect the Health and Safety of others and our employees.

2. Sackville Construction shall provide information, training, supervision, plant and equipment as necessary to identify, eliminate or control hazards and risks at the workplace and surrounding environments to whomever requires it.

3. All employees, subcontractors and visitors are expected to co-operate with Sackville Construction Ltd. in implementing all aspects of this policy. With particular reference, employees and sub-contractors advertantly or inadvertantly must ensure that their work, as far as reasonably practicable, is carried out without risk to themselves or others. Employees have a duty of care with regards to their own Health and Safety and must not endanger others.

4. All appropriate lengths will be taken to ensure safe means of handling, transportation, usage and storage of all materials and substances, with particular regard to the Environment.

5. Sackville Construction Ltd. intends to enforce all appropriate measures to continually monitor all risk factors to comply with Health and Safety legislation; striving for continual improvements in our practice to enhance positive Health and Safety at work to the satisfaction of all concerned.

6. Sackville Construction Ltd. maintains to be responsibly aware of any changes to current legislation and will review and amend this Policy, if required, in accordance with guidelines, or as a response to changes within the environment of the workplace or the Company, at any given time.
